A product of the Tri-State Lacrosse organization, Coach Green has grown up playing and working for Tri-State. Having graduated from Nazareth College with a degree in Business Administration and a Concentration in Marketing and Sports Management, Coach Green went on to work for the New Jersey Pride of Major League Lacrosse as Dir. of Operations in addition to coaching for Tri-State. In January 2007 he accepted a full time position with Tri-State and currently serves as Director of Camps & Clinics and Asst. HS All Star Director.

Coach Green will spend the Spring on the Montgomery High School sidelines as the Assistant Varsity Coach. Prior to taking the Montgomery position, he was the Head Freshman Lacrosse Coach at Moorestown High school where his team achieved an 8-2 record and a GAA of below four.

As a player, Coach Green was a 2-year starter for Nazareth in the cage. He was named 2nd Team All Empire 8 and was apart of the teams that played in the 2003 National Semifinals and 2004 National Finals. In HS, he was a 4-year Varsity starter for Hendrick Hudson (NY), where he was a 2x Team MVP, 3x All-Section Recipient and 3x All-League Recipient.

DIRECTIONS

**Dave Waks Memorial Park (Barbour Pond)
 Barbour Pond Drive - Wayne, NJ 07470**

From South, East, West: Take either Route 46 or I-80 to Route 23 North. Take Alps Road exit and follow to the 3rd traffic light, making a right onto Ratzler Road. At the first traffic light make a left onto Valley Road. Follow to the 2nd light, Barbours Pond Road and make a left. Fields are located at the end of the road down a long driveway/parking area. (If traveling I-80 East, you will need to take the Minniskink Road Exit & make the U-Turn onto I-80 West. Then follow I-80 West to Route 23 North as above. Alternative option is to exit I-80 East onto I-287 North and follow below directions).

From 287: Take Route 23 South Exit and take the Ratzler Road U-Turn (just after Fudrucker's). Stay in the right-hand Left turn lane to turn onto the service road (coming up past a Kohl's). At the top of the service road bear right to stay on Ratzler Road. Travel to 2nd traffic light, turning left onto Valley Road. Turn left at Barbour Pond Road (2nd traffic light) and follow to the end. Fields will be located down a driveway/parking lot.
